**ANIMALS' HABITAT ( HABITAT DE ANIMALES)**

<b>English / Inglés</b>	<b>Definition</b>
habitat	a place where an animal lives, finds its food and is sheltered
forest	a habitat that has enough rainfall for a thick growth of trees and plants
freshwater region	habitat areas where there is little or no salt in the water
wetlands	habitats where the land is wet and soggy most of the year
desert	a habitat that receives very little rainfall and have harsh temperatures (very hot during the day and very cold at night)
polar region	a habitat that has very cold temperatures and covered with snow and ice most of the year
Arctic	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Located near the North Pole</li> <li>* Very cold, snow covered ground most of the year</li> <li>* Mainly ice-covered ocean surrounded by frozen land</li> <li>* Has short summer when plants can grow</li> <li>* A place for animals that are designed to live in the cold</li> </ul>
Antartica	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Located at the South Pole</li> <li>* The coldest region on earth</li> <li>* Mainly ice-covered land surrounded by the ocean</li> <li>* A place where very few land animals live</li> <li>* A wide variety of animal life in and around the sea</li> </ul>
Tropical Rain Forest	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Warm and humid all year</li> <li>* Receive a large amount of rain</li> <li>* Home to almost half of all the earth's animals</li> <li>* Produce nuts, coffee, cocoa, bananas and many other foods</li> </ul>

Pollute	to make things so dirty or unclean that it is harmful to life
Reduce	to use less of something and not waste what you have
Reuse	to use something again
Recycle	to make new material from old ones
Migrate	travelling from one place to a warmer climate in the winter

food chain	the order in which animals eat plants and other animals
predator	the eater in the food chain
prey	the one being eaten in the food chain
camouflage	color or pattern that helps an animal hide in its habitat
nocturnal	animals that sleep during the day and are active at night
endangered	close to being extinct
extinct	no longer living
